Victorian Holiday Inn cluster.

Victoria is continuing to manage the cluster of cases associated with the Holiday Inn at Melbourne Airport. It has released a further three public exposure sites associated with this cluster today. They can be found at: <https://www.dhhs.vic.gov.au/case-locations-and-outbreaks-covid-19> . It is important that anyone who has been at any of the listed public exposure sites at the times listed follows Victorian Government requirements. This means they cannot travel to the island. Travellers are being reminded of this requirement on arrival at the airport.

EMT will continue to monitor the situation in Victoria.

Extension of the State of Emergency (Recovery)

The Administrator has approved the extension of the State of Emergency (Recovery) until the 30th of June 2021. This means that the existing structures (EMT and IMT) will remain in place for the management of the pandemic.

Immunisations

EMT is awaiting confirmation associated with vaccines and the immunisation strategy for the island. When further information is available it will be released through NIHRACS.
