Update regarding Victorian travellers to the island.

Victoria has introduced a five-day lock-down for the whole of Victoria from 11:59pm AEDST last night, Friday 12 February 2021. Travel is not allowed and therefore Victorian travellers will not be allowed to leave to come to the island during the lock-down period.

Anyone who has been in the Greater Melbourne Area since February 9th and has travelled to the island since then is required to self-isolate on the island until released by NIHRACS. This requirement includes Victorian travellers who maybe currently in transit to the island through either Sydney or Brisbane and expect to arrive in the next few days. The Victorian Government has also listed two public exposure sites at Terminal 4, Melbourne Airport yesterday. Anyone who has travelled through Terminal 4 on Tuesday February 9 and has arrived on the island is also required to self-isolate until released by NIHRACS.
