Early end to Victorian lockdown and self-isolation requirement on island.

The Victorian Premier has announced that the State's five-day lockdown will end as of mid-night tonight (Wednesday, February 17th). There have been no further cases of community transmission following from the Holiday Inn cluster. There are no longer Victorian Government restrictions on travel.

With this announcement it has been decided that anyone from Victoria who has had to undergo self-isolation can end this requirement from mid-night tonight (Norfolk Island time). Victorians will also be allowed to travel to the island and not have to undergo self-isolation.

Anyone who has been in a listed Victorian public exposure site must still follow the Victorian Government directions. These can be found at <https://www.dhhs.vic.gov.au/case-locations-and-outbreaks-covid-19>.
