NSW COVID-19 case locations and local requirements.

The NSW Government has released an updated list of case locations and instructions associated with the recent quarantine hotel case. These can be found at <https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/latest-news-and-updates>. Currently the main concern is with anyone who has visited “Pancake on the Rocks” on Saturday 13 March. Anyone who has visited the location is regarded as a close contact and must immediately get tested and self-isolate for 14 days, regardless of the result. Anyone who has visited a further five listed locations in Bexley North, Haymarket and Hurstville need to monitor for symptoms and get tested immediately and self-isolate if symptoms occur.

Anyone who has travelled to the island from Sydney since Saturday should check the NSW website.

If you have been at any of the close contact locations and have travelled to the island you are required to contact NIHRACS, get tested and self-isolate until directed by NIHRACS.
