Brisbane COVID alert close and casual contact requirements.

Following the recent finding of a cases in Brisbane the Queensland Government has issued requirements for close contacts listed at [Contact tracing — coronavirus \(COVID-19\) | Health and wellbeing | Queensland Government \(www.qld.gov.au\)](#) . Anyone who has travelled to the island from Brisbane since March 20th should check the Queensland Health contract tracing website.

Close contacts are required to quarantine at home immediately for 14 days and complete the Queensland contact tracing self-assessment. They will be contacted by Queensland Health for testing. Casual contacts are required to get tested immediately and self-isolate until they receive a negative result. People who have visited the listed low risk sites are required to monitor for symptoms.

If you have been to the close, casual or low risk sites at the times listed by the Queensland Government you should not travel to the island. If you are already on the island, you must contact NIHRACS.
