



## **MEDIA RELEASE**

*Requirement for travellers to the island to check that they have not been at a listed Public exposure site before travelling to the island.*

Following the identification of a community transmission case in NSW yesterday an updated list of public exposure sites has been issued. The list includes Hudson's Coffee stand and the Male toilet adjacent to gate 79 at the Brisbane International Airport Terminal on 29 April. People who were at these locations at the relevant time must self-isolate and get tested.

Other exposure venues are listed in NSW and require immediate quarantine at home and testing.

Travellers to the island are required to ensure that they have not been to the exposure sites at the relevant time. If they have, they should not travel to the island. If they are already on the island they should isolate at home or their accommodation and contact NIHRACS.

EMT will continue to monitor the situation.
