### **COVID-19 RELEASE FROM ISOLATION**

From today, Tuesday 31 March, the first people to undergo compulsory self-isolation will be able to move around once more in the Norfolk Island community. The next group in self-isolation to be released will be on Wednesday, 1 April.

Before their release, everyone who has been in compulsory self-isolation will be assessed by medical staff and the police to ensure they remain free of any symptoms and are feeling well.

Norfolk Island currently has no known cases of COVID-19.
