KEEPING NORFOLK SAFE

This media release is to advise the community that cold and flu like symptoms have presented in a person currently in self-isolation following travel. Testing for COVID-19 has been conducted and the result is pending. As a precautionary measure, all passengers who were on the same flight have been notified and have been advised that they will have to remain in self-isolation until the test result is returned. This may or may not result in additional days of self-isolation for this group of people.

As a precautionary measure, family and friends who may have previously been delivering food and supplies to this group of people will no longer be able to do so. Any such deliveries will need to be dropped to the Police Station and the Police will deliver to those in this group in isolation and meet their needs.

All persons on the flight have been contacted by the Norfolk Island Police Force and the situation has been explained to them.

This situation highlights how important it is that self-isolation requirements are adhered to.
