7-day extension to current restrictions for people arriving from NSW and the ACT

EMT met today and reviewed the current restriction applying to people who have spent time in NSW or the ACT in the preceding 14 days. Based on a continuing, but low level of community transmission in NSW it has been decided to extend the current restriction for a further seven (7) days. This means that up to the 31st of July anybody who has spent time in NSW, or the ACT is required to quarantine for 14 days on arrival into the island.

This requirement does not apply to passengers who have had to transit through Sydney airport in the same day on the way to Norfolk from the other states. The island remains closed to people from Victoria and hotspots listed on the Queensland Government website and entry passes will be denied from these areas.

The restrictions will be reviewed again next Monday.
