SALE OF TOBACCO ACT 2004
REMINDER TO ALL SELLERS OF TOBACCO IN NORFOLK ISLAND

Persons or businesses involved in the sale of tobacco in Norfolk Island are required to hold a licence under Section 7 of the *Sale of Tobacco Act 2004*.

All Sale of Tobacco (SOT) licences expire on 30 of June in the financial year in which they were issued regardless of when a licence is issued within that particular year. New applications by new business owners or renewal applications by business owners who already hold a SOT licence must be lodged in writing in the prescribed form together with payment of the full applicable licence fee at the Customer Care Facility of the Norfolk Island Regional Council.

The licensee must -

- Prominently display in the premises warnings and anti-smoking signs

The licensee must not -

- Supply, sell or cause or permit to be supplied or sold a tobacco product to a person under the age of 18 years;
- Sell a tobacco product other than for smoking;
- Sell something that looks like or resembles a tobacco product that is not;
- Sell cigarettes other than in packets of 20 or more;
- Manufacture tobacco products
