FIREARMS AND PROHIBITED WEAPONS ACT 1997 (NI)

I, Eric Russell Hutchinson, Administrator of Norfolk Island and delegate of the Commonwealth Minister, specify, pursuant to section 6A of the *Firearms and Prohibited Weapons Act 1997* (NI) (the Act), an amnesty period to commence on the date of publication of this instrument in the Gazette and to cease on 30 September 2017.

The amnesty period applies in respect of:

- a) the prohibition in subsection 6(1) of the Act on possession of a firearm without a licence or permit; and
- b) the prohibition in subsection 35(1) of the Act on possession of an unregistered firearm.
