INTERPRETATION ACT 1979 NOTIFICATION OF FEE INCREASES

I, Eric Russell Hutchinson, Administrator of Norfolk Island and delegate of the Commonwealth Minister under item 1.50 of the *Minister's Norfolk Island Delegation Instrument 2017 (No. 1)* (CTH); hereby advise members of the Norfolk Island community that, under section 12B of the *Interpretation Act 1979* as amended by Part 4, section 7 of the *Norfolk Island Continued Laws Amendment (2017 Measures No. 1) Ordinance 2017* (CTH), all statutory fees that are expressed in fee units have increased as from 1 July 2017.

The value of one fee unit has increased from \$25.20 to \$28.40 to be applied in the following manner:

In an enactment, a reference to a number, whether whole or fractional, of **fee units** is a reference to:

- (a) for a number of fee units less than 2—the amount of money in dollars determined by multiplying the number of fee units by \$28.40 and rounding the result to the nearest whole dollar amount (rounding 50 cents up); or
- (b) for a number of fee units greater than, or equal to, 2—the amount of money in dollars determined by multiplying the number of fee units by \$28.40 and rounding the result to the nearest whole multiple of 5 dollars (rounding odd multiples of \$2.50 up).

The monetary amount of a fee expressed in fee units is calculated as follows –

Fee units less than 2	\$ fee = fee units x \$ 28.40	rounded to nearest whole dollar (fifty cents rounded up)
Fee units 2 or more	\$ fee = fee units x \$ 28.40	rounded to nearest whole multiple of \$5 (odd multiples of \$2.50 are rounded up)

Although no longer required by section 12B of the *Interpretation Act 1979* as amended, a list of the dollar amounts as at 1 July 2017 of all fees specified in fee units is published in this Gazette.
