WORKERS COMPENSATION COMPLAINTS EMPLOYMENT CONCILIATION BOARD

One of the functions of the Employment Conciliation Board is to deal with complaints lodged with members of the Board relating to workers compensation.

An aggrieved person may lodge a complaint with any member of the Board concerning:

- A complaint or grievance arising out of an unsuccessful worker's compensation claim made by the employee' or
- Any other matter in relation to compensation for work-related accidents.
