

CRUISE SHIP UPDATE

Two more cruise ships are due to arrive at Norfolk Island next week!



P&O Cruises - Pacific Jewel (1900 passengers) is due Sunday 31 December 2017.

This ship is expecting passengers to disembark from 7:00am – 4:00pm. Passengers will be shuttled between the pier (either Kingston or Cascade) and Rawson Hall transit point. Some passengers are engaged in tours for the morning but all cruisers will be encouraged to enjoy local shops, eateries and the Sunday markets.

Seabourn Cruise – Seabourn Encore (600 passengers) is due Tuesday 2 January 2018.

This ship is expecting passengers to disembark from 8:00am – 5:00pm. Passengers will be shuttled between the pier (either Kingston or Cascade) and a central town transit point.



Norfolk Island Tourism is looking for volunteer ambassadors able to disperse themselves around town on cruise ship days and willing to help answer questions from cruisers. Volunteers will be provided with a pack of information and maps for visitors.

A 'Cruise Market' is encouraged at the pier in a designated area for stallholders, food and drink, entertainers, buskers and community fundraising groups.
